




Welcome to the Nativity Trail

- ★ Follow the map around the trail. Along the way look out for light boxes in windows. You can start anywhere on the map.
- ★ You have been given an approximate location for the light boxes but you will need to keep your eyes open!
- ★ All light boxes are easily seen from the pavement so there is no need to go up peoples driveways or paths.
- ★ Once you've spotted the light box word, find the sticker in your pack that matches the word in the window and put it in the box made for it on your sheet. Then have a look at the question which you can think about as you make your way to the next nativity stop.
- ★ Make sure you read the "Staying safe on the trail guidance" overleaf so you can have a safe and wonderful time.



Staying safe on your Nativity Trail

Here's a few guidelines to keep you safe as you walk around your nativity trail.

- ★ This activity is for groups of 6 and no more, in line with government guidelines. If there are people at the light stop already, maintain the correct social distance and wait for them to move on.
- ★ Make sure a responsible adult or guardian goes on the nativity trail and stays with any children for the whole event.
- ★ Be especially careful as you cross roads.
- ★ Wear reflective or light coloured clothing so you can be seen.
- ★ Carry a torch to help avoid falling over. Also hand sanitiser in case you touch anything as you go round.
- ★ Be respectful as you walk around the neighbourhood
- ★ You will be able to see everything you need from the pavement – do not enter gardens, porches or go up to residences.
