We have some exciting opportunities to join the staff team at Emmaus School. Emmaus is a non-denominational Christian school that welcomes children of different abilities from all backgrounds.

We aim to educate children to a high standard in the context of a Christian world view. Our Inspection in June 2023 judged the personal development of our pupils to be excellent and our teaching to be good: **“Pupils display excellent attitudes to their learning, demonstrating an intrinsic desire to do well.”**

We have a vacancy for a part-time **Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator**, ideally someone with a teaching background and experience of SEN work. We anticipate that this role will be 0.2 WTE.

Part-time teaching opportunities in **Scripture (KS3)** and **Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) Education (KS3)** are also available. The latter opportunities are a few hours per week so would ideally suit someone already working elsewhere. Salaries for all roles depend on qualifications, skills and experience.

We are looking for candidates with: enthusiasm and aptitude for teaching; excellent administrative and organisational skills; classroom management skills; willingness to develop professionally; commitment to safeguarding of children; and awareness of health and safety at school. A formal teaching qualification may not be necessary, as teacher training will be given. Commitment to the Christian ethos of the school is essential.

We offer: an environment that aims to be Christ-centred in its teaching and values; small class sizes; responsive young people and supportive colleagues. The School is committed to the safeguarding and welfare of all pupils. We practice safer recruitment and all appointments are subject to an enhanced DBS check and barred list check for regulated activity. These roles are exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974.
